WE ARE COLLECTING PLASTIC LIDS/CAPS! Another organization was found that collects these hard plastic covers and uses the money to purchase wheelchairs for the disabled. It is very easy to do. They accept any color plastic, but ask that you remove any metal or paper attached to the plastic and make sure all lids are washed and clean before donating.
